Elevator Pitch

Amazónico is a circular economy operating system that connects households, businesses, and recyclers to recover waste with full traceability. We transform post-consumer materials into measurable climate impact, social inclusion, and sustainable compliance.

Climate Problem

In Latin America, much of the waste ends up in landfills, generating emissions and leading to material loss. Amazónico mitigates this impact by recovering post-consumer waste with traceability and integrating waste pickers into the climate solution.

Solution

Amazónico turns waste management into a shared value proposition: it promotes source separation, traceable collection, incentives for users (both waste generators and managers), and verifiable data so that companies can measure their impact and close the loop.

Revenue Model

We generate revenue through B2B contracts for Extended Producer Responsibility, traceability, environmental stewardship, and closed-loop systems; B2C memberships; the sale of recovered materials; and impact reports.

Target Market

Our market includes B2B customers with Extended Producer Responsibility obligations and environmental, social, and governance goals; waste-generating users looking for easy recycling options; and waste management companies requiring traceability and revenue streams.
