Circular Amazon is a circular economy startup that transforms paiche fish skin waste into sustainable leather for innovative fashion accessories, integrating traditional Kené designs of Indigenous communities in Peru's Protected Natural Areas.

We address waste pollution by transforming fish waste into sustainable materials and promoting circular economy practices. We also promote and preserve Amazonian culture by integrating traditional Shipibo-Conibo Kené designs into each fashion accessory.

## Solution

---

Circular Amazon transforms Paiche fish waste into sustainable leather fashion. Besides that, we also want to commercialize Amazonian Sustainable Art & Decor to market sustainably sourced, handcrafted Amazonian products.

## Revenue Model

---

Circular Amazon will generate revenue through the sale of sustainable fashion accessories made from paiche fish leather, including bags, wallets, and handmade products featuring traditional Kené designs and Amazonian Sustainable Art & Décor.

Sustainable fashion hit \$8.1B in 2024 and grows 22.9% yearly to \$33.1B by 2033. Shipibo-Conibo artist Sara Flores redesigned Dior's Lady Dior bags using Kené patterns on vegan leather—hailed worldwide.

Nova Kaeru in Brazil and Qaya in Peru. However, Circular Amazon differentiates itself by integrating traditional Shipibo-Conibo Kené designs into each product and offering Amazonian sustainable art and décor products.
