Ecomuna is Costa Rica's marketplace for sustainable products, connecting conscious consumers with verified eco-friendly alternatives. We promote sustainable lifestyles by bringing together the market's scattered green offerings on a single platform.

Climate Problem

Unsustainable consumption accounts for 60% of global emissions. In Costa Rica, conscious consumers face barriers to accessing sustainable products: scattered availability, a lack of verification, and uncompetitive prices.

Solution

We bring together sustainable products in an accessible marketplace. We curate eco-friendly brands, ensure authenticity through rigorous standards, and offer competitive prices. We make responsible consumption as easy as shopping at any store.

Revenue Model

Through two channels: brick-and-mortar stores and e-commerce. We earn a 30% commission on third-party brand products sold on our marketplace and a 70% margin on our own-brand products. This model allows us to scale while maintaining sustainable profitability.

Target Market

Women aged 25–40 in Costa Rica who are environmentally conscious and have a middle-class socioeconomic status. They seek to reduce their environmental impact through responsible consumption.

We have been in business for seven years, with steady growth year after year. Demand for organic, natural, and plastic-free products is constantly increasing, as evidenced by our sales in both our physical store and online.
