Is a pollinator-friendly native garden beside a cattle corral that blends biodiversity, education, and tourism.
Differentiator: women-led model turning livestock spaces into living classrooms and sustainable income sources.

Climate Problem

Our startup addresses biodiversity loss and land degradation from conventional cattle farming. It matters because restoring habitats improves climate resilience, captures carbon, and sustains ecosystem services vital for rural livelihoods.

Solution

We create pollinator gardens with native plants beside cattle corrals, integrating conservation into farming. Through women-led nurseries, training, and services, we restore habitats, boost biodiversity, and create sustainable income.

Revenue Model

We generate revenue by selling native plants, providing garden design and installation services, offering training workshops, producing stingless bee honey, and developing eco-tourism experiences on the farm.

Target Market

Our target market includes cattle farmers, rural landowners, eco-tourism operators, NGOs, and public programs seeking nature-based solutions, biodiversity restoration, and sustainable, women-led climate initiatives.
